



Announcement of Faculty of Medicine, Mahasarakham University

Subject: No Gift Policy

In reference to an announcement from the Office the Prime Minister on the subject of 'An Announcement of National Reform Plan' (Revised Editions), issued on 23rd February 2024, under the National Reform Plan on Prevention, Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition), a drive to develop Thai bureaucracy is determined to be unprofitably transparent. Regarding objective 1 item 1.1, every state agency must declare itself as an organization with all its staff refraining from all kinds of present and gifts by their duty performance (or No Gift Policy).

Hence, to drive activities of reform under the National Reform Plan above; to establish transparency within the agency, to shape values of performing duties, and to practice an honest culture, Faculty of Medicine, Mahasarakham University declares to all executives, government officers, administrators, and staff of the faculty refraining from inquiries of all kind of present and gifts by their duty performance (or No Gift Policy); on all celebrations and special occasions. Aside from an inevitable occurrence, he/she must follow the rules of present or gift acceptance or other benefits, under the regulations of the office of Prime Minister on the subject of giving or accepting gifts to government officers B.E. 2544 (2001); announced by the National Anti-Corruption Commissioners on the subject of 'Rules of Property or Other Profit Acceptancy toward the Government Officer's Ethics B.E. 2563 (2020)

This announcement will accordingly be informed to all executives, government officers, employees, administrations, and staff in the faculty conscientiously following the policy.
